Bill Golis presented "10.1.500 New Top Features" which included an overview of new fixes and enhancements, new service job tracker, payroll key enhancements, framework and tools enhancements and much more. Bill's presentation is available for review <u>here</u>

Calvin Dekker's presentation "Budgeting IT and Future Projects" started with the basic 3 Components of a Budget: 1) Run the business; 2) Grow the business; and 3) Transform and evolve the business; and offered tips such as hardware replacement time frames, recommended software upgrades, and to remember to budget for training and education, supplier fees, subscription and more. Kevin Gallagher gave a preview of a new tool for Epicor: the ERP Analyzer digs into your hardware environment to provide a detailed report of all findings. Users on 9.05 will run this tool, which will document customizations. He discussed users' concerns about how intrusive it is to their system. Epicor's intent is to have your 10.1 data (without customizations) in a cloud to facilitate

upgrades in a much shorter time.

The meeting was paused for a break for luncheon which included breakout discussion groups by job functions. At the end of the lunch break, Calvin Dekker held a drawing for gift cards and/or centerpieces. Following the break, **Ryan King demonstrated the Data Migration Tool (DMT)** which will auto update and automate purchasing, jobs, sales orders, purchase orders, price lists, generate shipments and more. DMT is much quicker and more stable than Service Connect and is useful whenever you need to move large amounts of data, not just for upgrades.
